**Branch:** Electrical and Plumbing

**Salary:** \$28.98 to \$32.20/hr, in addition to a comprehensive benefits plan and pension

**Basic Function:** Reporting to the Electrical/Plumbing Supervisor, this position is responsible for performing with minimum supervision, skilled tasks in the installation, maintenance, and repair of the physical plant. This position is also responsible for assisting and providing support in implementing the Strategic Plan.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

An employee in this classification is required to perform duties consisting of, but not restricted to, the operation, repairs, installations & Preventative maintenance of all water supply systems, storm & sanitary systems, pools, ponds, fish tanks and associated equipment, pumps & filtration equipment.

Assist in related maintenance duties.

Prepares material lists if requested for projects or work orders.

Advises other units regarding requested installations or repairs.

Performs all duties in compliance with municipal, provincial, or federal requirements and within standards set by the Toronto Zoo.

Required to work shifts, holidays, and weekends as scheduled.

Other related duties as requested by the Supervisor.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

Must possess a certificate of trade qualification valid in the Province of Ontario, for Plumber.

Must have a minimum of 3 or more years of proven experience.

Experienced in all aspects of the plumbing trade including water supply, fire hydrants & sprinkler systems, sanitary & storm systems, pools, ponds, filtration and pumping systems.

Must be able to read architectural, mechanical, and electrical plans and schematic drawings.

Must be able to read, understand and utilize technical manuals.

Must be able to meet the physical demands of the job.

Must possess a non-probationary Class G driver's licence valid in the Province of Ontario, along with a good driving record.

Must have working knowledge of WHMIS legislation, the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act, and Toronto Zoo Safety Policy.

Must possess a working knowledge of the Ontario Building code and Plumbing code and all other code & regulations affecting their work.
