Government of Canada invests \$769,902 to enhance tourism and community infrastructure in Scarborough— Rouge Park

FedDev Ontario supports the Toronto Zoo to drive community revitalization, tourism and local economic growth

The Government of Canada is committed to supporting tourism and community infrastructure in southern Ontario by ensuring local businesses, and the organizations that support them, have the tools they need to position themselves for a strong and resilient economic future.

Today, on behalf of the Honourable Filomena Tassi, Minister responsible for the Federal Economic Development Agency for Southern Ontario (<u>FedDev Ontario</u>), Gary Anandasangaree, Member of Parliament for Scarborough— Rouge Park, announced a total combined investment of \$769,902 to support 3 projects in Scarborough— Rouge Park under the <u>Tourism Relief Fund (TRF)</u> and the <u>Canada Community Revitalization Fund (CCRF)</u>.

The announcement was made at an event hosted by the Toronto Zoo, which is receiving a non-repayable contribution of \$769,902 under the Tourism Relief Fund (TRF)/Canada Community Revitalization Fund (CCRF), to provide year-round access to greenhouses, increase accessibility for persons with disabilities, and adapt operations to meet COVID-19 health and safety regulations.

- The Toronto Zoo receives approximately 1.3 million visitors per year.
- The Toronto Zoo employs 273 permanent full-time staff and over 330 part-time and seasonal employees.
- With a national investment of \$500 million over two years, the <u>Canada Community Revitalization</u> Fund supports projects that build new community infrastructure and revitalize existing assets, bring people back to public spaces safely and stimulate local economies. This includes \$139 million for projects in southern Ontario, delivered by FedDev Ontario.
- The Government of Canada's \$500-million Tourism Relief Fund is helping tourism-oriented businesses and organizations recover from the pandemic and prepare for future growth, with a minimum of \$50 million of the Fund allocated to supporting Indigenous-led projects or Indigenous-focused projects. FedDev Ontario is delivering nearly \$120 million of the Tourism Relief Fund across southern Ontario.
