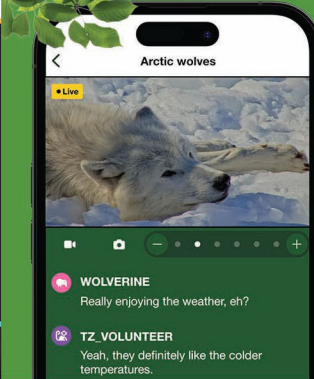
### Your Toronto Zoo Vision:

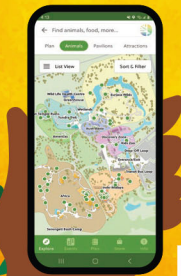

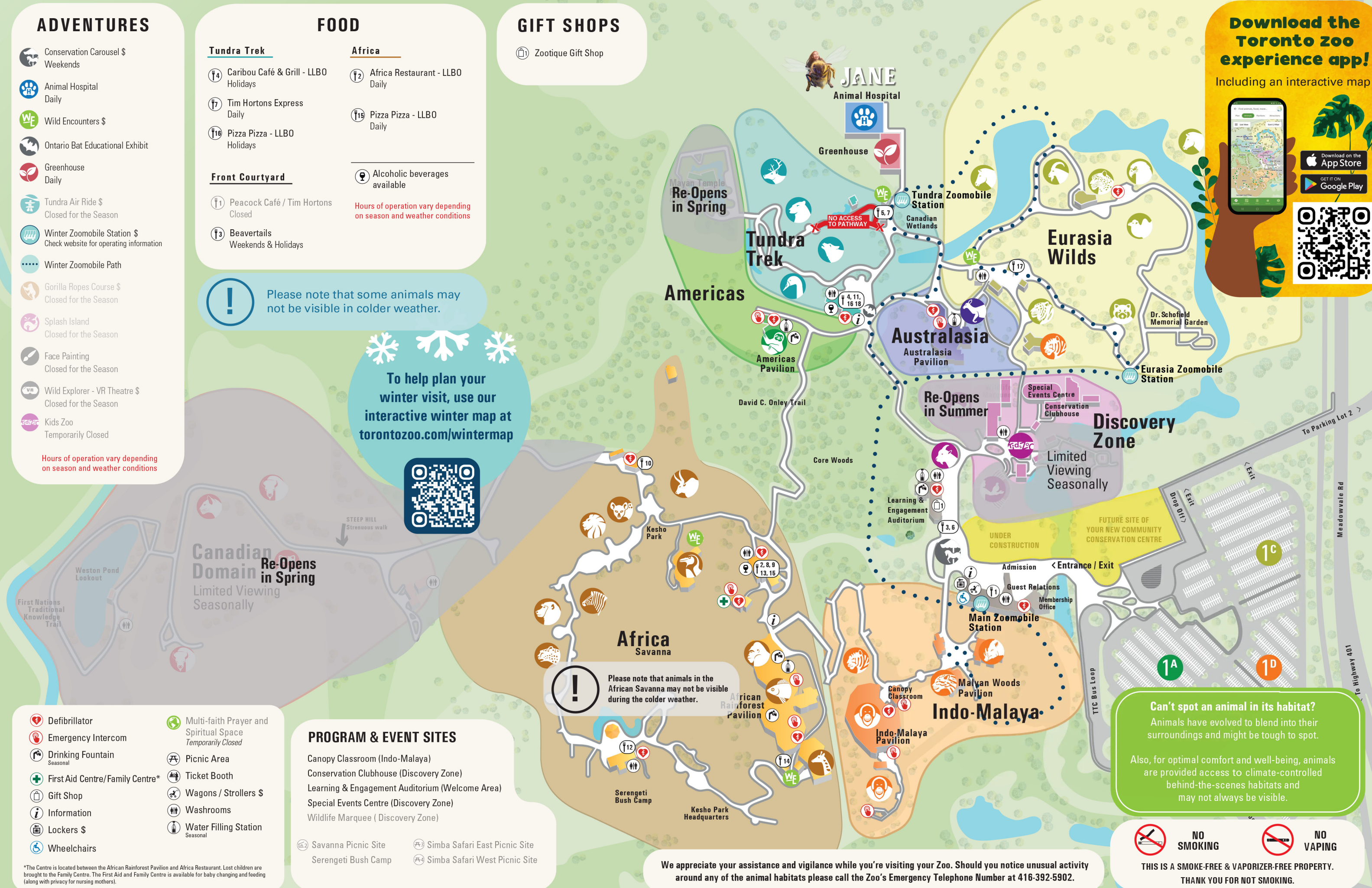
